After settling into your room, take a leisurely stroll along the banks of the Rapti river, soaking in the tranquil ambiance. As the sun begins to set, head to the observation tower for a mesmerizing view of the sunset, painting the sky with vibrant hues. And to add a perfect ending to your day, immerse yourself in the rich cultural heritage of Chitwan with a captivating performance by the Tharu ethnic group, showcasing their traditional tribal dance. DAY 3 Elephant Safari, Canoe ride, nature walk and elephant breeding center
